But correctly understood and executed, BPR offers a robust solution to prevailing thorny issues in the generation and use of effective management information. This presentation will examine core aspects of BPR, specifically,

2. BPR triggers - when is BPR advisable, necessary, or indispensable?
3. BPR variants
4. Effective BRP methodology
5. Measures of successful BPR

About the Speaker

Ndubuisi is a chartered management accountant and management information systems consultant.

He also has interests in academia, delivering courses and conducting business research. He is a visiting professor at SKEMA Business School, Paris. He is also a visiting lecturer at Kingston Business School, Surrey, UK, delivering seminars and workshops to doctoral research associates as well as masters students.

He holds a doctorate degree in business administration (DBA). He is the originator of the Specific Business Needs Model of ERP System implementation and has authored various papers.

Dr Anomelechi's professional career has included roles in banking, financial management and control, project controls and management, BPR, and system implementation and management in a variety of organisations in the financial services, commercial, engineering, oil and gas, information technology, professional services, and the public sectors.
