

## How to reach Hôtel du Lac Enghien-Les-Bains



### By plane:

- Aéroport Roissy-Charles-de-Gaulle 20km. (30 - 45 min.)

### By train:

- SNCF Gare Enghien-les-Bains - 15 min. Train ride from Paris, Gare du Nord - trains depart every 10 min. Direction Pontoise or Valmondois
- RER Gare Saint-Gratien, line C direction Montigny - Beauchamp - Argenteuil. Station is 2km from Hotel.

### By car:

- 12 km. From Paris - Porte de la Chapelle, on Autoroute A1 exit no. 3 Saint Denis, follow Epinay-sur-Seine then Enghien-les-Bains
- 15km. From Paris - Porte Maillot - on Autoroute A86 towards Cergy Pontoise take A15 then exit no. 2 Enghien-Montmorency
